“Basic Training”

OBJECTIVES

OBJECTIVE ONE: The State of Georgia per Georgia Code sections 36-A-20 and 36-62A-21 requires all Georgia Development Authority Board Members to meet the legal requirement of eight (8) hours of basic classroom training within one (1) year of appointment. Therefore, the Basic Training is focused on assisting local development authorities to obtain compliance in accordance with the Georgia Code.

OBJECTIVE TWO: The Basic Training Program is designed to offer development authority members, their staffs, their legal counsel and the tax assessor an opportunity to obtain basic information regarding their responsibilities as members or participants of the local economic development process.
